Tournament organizers retain the right to make changes in the schedule. In case of any changes you will be informed via the tournament board.

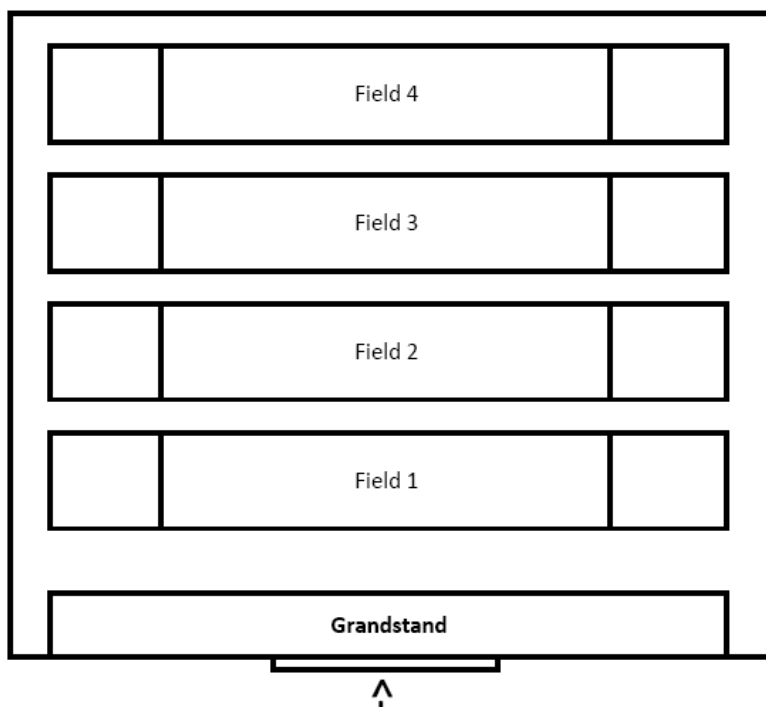
- Please report **Game and Spirit** scores to the staff after each game.
- Let **Your Player Numbers to be Seen** to the scorekeepers after you assisted or made a point as we are writing it down.
- Scorekeepers are there to keep your score. They probably can't answer your questions about the rules. But each scorekeeper has set of rules with them, which you can borrow.
- **Post-Game Talks can be done outside the fields.** For safety reasons, we ask that all players stay away from the free areas between the fields.

**OTHER INFORMATION:** Please help us keep the fields clean by **collecting all your trash in the bags** we provide. Due to very tight schedules, we ask those teams who are not playing in the next game to leave the fields. We don't lock the rooms so we assume you to keep your personal things with you by the fields. Take care that your personal belongings do not disturb the games and interfere players. If you break anything you pay for everything ;) !

**FIELDS:** The field size is 60 x 20; end zone is 12m deep; brick mark is 10 meters from the end zone and marked with a tape on the perimeter line.

**For safety reasons - Please do not take your staff between the fields.**

Water battles and discs are ok, but for everything else there's plenty of room on the sides of the hall or on the grandstand.



# SPECIAL KICK TOURNAMENT RULES:

## CAPTAINS!

IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO MAKE SURE THAT  
EVERYONE IN YOUR TEAM KNOWS THESE RULES!!!

We are using official **WFDF rules of Ultimate 2013**. But with some Kick special modifications.

All games in all rounds (except the Open and Women division thirds and finals) will be played to 11 points or to 25 minutes. When time-cap is reached, finish the point. If no team has reached 11points, add 1 to the leading score to set the new point cap. SOTG scores are collected from all the games ☺

**PAGACAP :** Pagacap is used only in pool games. If one team leads by three or more points when time is up, then the game is over. If not, then one point is “added” to the highest score. The first team to reach that score will win. When the time cap is reached during a point, the point is still played, and then the pagacap rule is used.

**LATE ARRIVAL TO GAME:** The game clock will start immediately the field is free. If one or both teams aren't ready to play after the first three minutes, the team(s) will be penalized with one point for every minute they are late.

**CALLAHAN GOAL :** A goal is scored when a player catches any legal pass in the end zone of attack.

**PULL :** The outdoor rules are valid for the pull. Just to remind you: You cannot drop it, if it lands out; you can take it to the brick mark; if it slides out you can take it to the goal line.

**TIME OUT:** Each team has 1 time-out (one minute) per game. After a goal and prior to the ensuing Pull, either team captain may call a time-out. During the points only the person with the disc may call a time-out. No timeout may be called in the final three (3) minutes of a game. You'll hear the jingle which states 3 minute till the end of the game.

**STALL COUNT:** Stall Count is 10 seconds

**JINGLES:** We are using jingles to let you know when it's 3 minutes to the game; 1 minute to the game; when the game starts; when it's 3 minutes to play; when it's 1 minute game time left; and when the time cap is over.



**PS!** If you see that the game starting jingle has already played, but the previous game hasn't ended yet - then be ready to play by the whistles of scorekeepers☺. We still want you to get the whole length of playing time ☺

**PS2!** It is very likely that we will stop using jingles in middle of the Sunday as the games are getting more intense and equal so it will be harder to keep them in the time limits.

**TIE BREAKERS:** If two teams end up with the same number of points, you go to the head to head result. If three or more teams end up with the same number of points, you make a separate result table counting only the results of the games between the tied teams. If teams still are tied, you count goal difference in the games between the tied teams. After that goals scored, and finally goal difference counting all games.

**RULES IN FINAL GAMES:** Rules for the third place game + finals. Games are played to 13 points, time cap 35 minutes. Halftime is on 6 points for 5 minutes. 2 time outs (one minute) in a game; 1 in both halftimes.

**NOTE:** As the game schedule is so tight and there are so many games per day, we plead you to leave the field immediately after game, so that the next game can begin on time.

## SOME FACTS FOR YOUR OWN GOOD

### THE FIELD:

- The field temperature is a bit chilly so you might consider taking long base trousers and long sleeved shirt.
- The artificial grass is ok for normal cleats and of course for the arti.grass cleats too. The normal trainers might be a bit slippery. The field is newly built and with the high quality artificial grass.

### FOOD AND DRINK ON THE FIELD:

- **Hot water is provided with teabags and coffee for free with your own cup**, on the stands at the FREE CAFE.
- Our lovely club members are bringing some snacks to get you going in the Saturday morning find them at the FREE CAFE.
- There will be a sport drink tap next to the staff table - use it while you can. There's quite a lot of it, but still it's limited.
- On both days at lunch time expect some gorgeous RED BULL girls to share some energy.
- **Lunches will be given by the staff table (near the entrance door) at 12:00 on Saturday and 12:00 on Sunday.** The food will be given to the whole team together. We need some time to sort your team back, so come around, but be patient.



## MEDALS:

- There will be given 8 medals per team ☺ ( but the extra medals will be ordered and will be sent to you ☺ )

## PHYSIOTHERAPIST (FIRST AID; KINESIO TAPING; MASSAGE):

- First aid - The basic things are by the physiotherapist table (cold, bandages, wound disinfect stuff etc) If there's something really serious ask the score keeper or somebody who speaks Estonian to call for an ambulance.
- Our lovely physiotherapist is ready to help you with your problems. She can tape you with kinesiotape (5€ with our tape ; 0€ with your tape ) or massage your sore muscles (5€ per session aprox 15minutes)

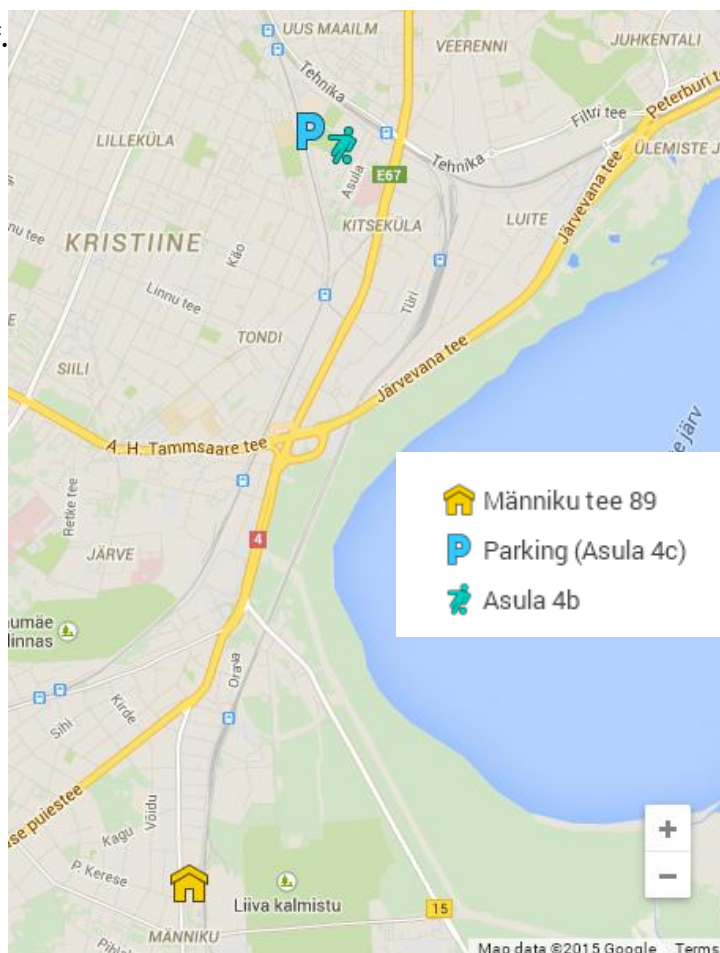
